Please note that Monday, October 14 is a holiday (Thanksgiving Day) and September 13 is a pedagogical day.

Rule of the month for the children - information

September-October

«I learn to respect the rules of the classroom and the school.»

Towards the end of October, certificates will be issued to the students who have best complied with the rule. Photos will be taken and posted on the honour roll at the school entrance.

A gesture for the planet: THE ZERO-WASTE LUNCH BOX - action

Help provide a clean and healthy environment for our students by replacing disposable packaging in your child's lunch box with reusable containers.

It's so simple! Here are some ideas:

- Replace juice boxes or water bottles with a canteen
- For sandwiches, replace plastic bags such as Ziploc and aluminum foil with reusable plastic containers such as Tupperware
- Pour small amounts of yogurt/comote into reusable containers
- Cut strips of cheese and put them in reusable containers instead of using pre-packaged 'Ficello' type cheeses

- Bake soft muffins and bars (without nuts or peanuts!) at home and place them in reusable containers

- The zero-waste lunch box is not only good for the planet, it is also economical, because food purchased in large sizes is cheaper than food purchased in single portions!

School regulations

Opening hours of the secretariat - information

Between 8:00 and 4:00. As soon as you leave the secretariat, you must leave through the main door. It is prohibited to go to the daycare centre from the inside. You must leave the school and enter through the daycare door.

To parents of students who use school transportation - important information

We are counting on your cooperation to ensure that your child has his or her bus pass when he or she goes to school. If your child loses his or her card, he or she must go to the secretariat. **IMPORTANT:** No child will be able to take the bus if they do not have their card with them. During the first few weeks of school, it is possible that transportation may be slower or errors may occur (e.g., child missing the bus). We ask for your cooperation and patience in this matter.

For parents who apply for a fee, the school bus service will process the applications in mid-September. .

Access to the floors

It is strictly forbidden for parents to circulate on the floors unless you have received an invitation from the holder or as a volunteer.

Schoolyard: Children's waiting area - action

A very big thank you to all our parents for respecting the children's waiting area at the end of the day and in the morning (behind the fence). By staying close to the fence, it is much easier for supervisors to keep all children safe.

Punctuality of children (primary school children) - action

Please make sure to leave your child in the yard 10 minutes before the start of classes. Delays are always stressful and disturbing to the teacher and friends in the classroom. Thank you for your essential collaboration in this matter.

Absences - action

If your child is absent, we ask you to inform us before 7:30 a.m. by calling (514) 596-4533 ext. 4849. It is very important to leave her name, group number and teacher's name. Don't forget to also notify the daycare service at (514) 596-5239, if your child is registered.

Start of classes for primary school students in Barclay- information

Preschool and elementary students are invited to arrive in the schoolyard at 8:30 am. The bells ring at 8:37.

If your child is late, he or she must then go through the secretariat to get a late ticket. No student should enter the daycare door as soon as classes have started. We are counting on your collaboration

Childcare service - information

Daycare begins at 7 a.m. and ends at 6 p.m.

DayCare Guide

The daycare guide will be hand-delivered to you by Mrs. Nassera, a daycare technician, at the end of September.

SDG Office Hours of Operation - Information

Parents who wish to meet the daycare technician Ms. Nassera Haoua must use the daycare door (not the secretariat door) at the following times:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 8:15 am to 11:15 am to 4:15 pm

Attendance at daycare and lunch service - action

For any change in attendance, you must absolutely complete a change of attendance form (website or at the SDG office) 10 business days in advance. Please also inform the teacher by writing in your child's diary.

SDG and lunch service fee payments - action

Please pay your fees as soon as you receive your statement of account at the beginning of each month for the month that begins. Note that the SDG only accepts payments by debit card, cheque or internet (highly recommended).

Lunch box - information

Your child must arrive in the morning with his lunch box. We cannot ensure the delivery of the forgotten lunch boxes every day. Exceptionally, if your child forgets it, you must leave it at the school office only. The lunch box must be identified with the child's name and the group. Please do not drop it off at the SDG.

Please identify the backpack, lunch box, and jacket with your child's name and group number.

Pedagogical days

You have until September 11 to return the response of the pedagogical days.

We remind you that we do not accept children registered outside the established deadline.

For dinners, if you need the service on pedagogical days, contact the daycare technician by e-mail or by phone, ideally within the September 11 deadline.
